Bob Warke Scholarship - 2010

Bob Warke was the heart and soul of Hokendauqua youth sports. His participation spanned four decades and his first concern was always the development of children. The HPPA Bob Warke Scholarship is a testimonial in recognition to his lifelong dedication to the associations and the youth of the area.

Each year, the HPPA will award two \$1,000 scholarships in Bob Warke's memory to one girl and one boy who has met the eligibility requirements, been evaluated on the scholarship criteria, graduated from high school within the current fiscal year and will continue their education at a university, college or trade school within the next six months.

Eligibility

Eligibility for the scholarship requires that the applicant must have participated in a HPPA athletic program for at least two years and completed their 8th grade eligibility. If an applicant participated in the HPPA's Baseball, Softball or Basketball programs for two years and then played on a high school freshman sports team when they were in 8th grade, they remain eligible for the scholarship.

To apply for the scholarship, all applicants must complete a Bob Warke Scholarship Application. HPPA members with voting privileges will review all of the applications at the July meeting and vote for the one girl and one boy to receive the \$1,000 scholarships at the August meeting. Winners will be notified and receive their award after the voting has taken place.
